Starting at Line 27: In counties where $\frac{1}{2}$ or more of the precinct committeemen and precinct committeewomen positions are filled, only precinct committeemen, precinct committeewomen, and current county central committee officers may vote for officers at the county convention. In counties where less than $\frac{1}{2}$ of the precinct committeemen and precinct committeewomen positions are filled, a Central Committee may chose to allow all Central Committee members in good standing to vote at the County Convention to elect officers. Good standing is defined as attending at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of the county central committee meetings held over the previous 12 months. Attendance by speakerphone is acceptable. Officers are not required to be precinct committeemen or precinct committeewomen... the rest of 2) unchanged
